*Technique:*

*Description from a recent class at a local shop: "While curves are intimidating for many quilters, this modern quilt pattern makes piecing curves simple! The smaller quilt is the same as the larger version but made using smaller blocks. Stitching curves in the larger size option is the best size for late beginner to intermediate quilters. It is more challenging to make the smaller version which is for late intermediate quilters*

# Toffee-Pumpkin Pie Bars

Found: A tasty, easy pumpkin dessert recipe that's perfect for your next party!

**Prep Time:** 30 mins

**Bake Time:** 50 mins

**Total Time:** 1 hr 20 mins

**Servings:** 32

**Yield:** 32 bars

## Ingredients

- 1 recipe Ginger Crumb Crust
- 1 15 ounce can pumpkin
- $\frac{3}{4}$  cup packed brown sugar
- $1\frac{1}{4}$  teaspoon ground cinnamon
- $\frac{3}{4}$  teaspoon ground ginger
- $\frac{1}{2}$  teaspoon salt
- $\frac{1}{4}$  teaspoon ground cloves
- 4 eggs, lightly beaten
- $1\frac{1}{2}$  cup half-and-half or light cream
- $\frac{1}{2}$  cup toffee pieces
- 1 cup chopped pecans, toasted
- Caramel-flavor ice cream topping (optional)



## Directions

### Step 1

Preheat oven to 375°F. Line a 13×9-inch baking pan with foil, extending the foil over the edges of the pan. Lightly grease foil. Press the Ginger Crumb Crust evenly and firmly onto the bottom of the prepared pan; set aside.

### Step 2

For filling, in a large bowl combine pumpkin, brown sugar, cinnamon, ginger, salt, and cloves. Add eggs; beat lightly with a fork until combined. Gradually add half-and-half; stir just until combined. Pour filling into crust-lined pan.

### Step 3

Bake for 40 to 45 minutes or until a knife inserted near the center comes out clean. Sprinkle top with toffee pieces and pecans. Cool in pan on a wire rack.

### Step 4

Using the edges of the foil, lift the uncut bars out of the pan. Cut into bars. Cover and chill within 2 hours. If desired, drizzle with caramel topping just before serving.

## Ginger Crumb Crust

In a medium bowl combine 3 cups crushed gingersnaps (13 oz.),  $\frac{1}{4}$  cup sugar, and  $\frac{1}{4}$  cup all-purpose flour. Add  $\frac{1}{2}$  cup melted butter and stir until well combined.
