Dye Day at Jammin on Vegas April 1st: 11AM to 4PM

Have you ever wanted to learn to dye your own quilt fabric but have no idea where to start? Selecting fabric, choosing dye, understanding how the chemicals work and knowing how to wash it out safely is all a bit overwhelming for someone new to dying. Join us as the expert dye artists at Jammin on Vegas teach you all about the process of tie dye and dip dying at this event. They'll have all the supplies you need, clean up all the mess and answer all of your questions. You'll leave the event with 2 full yards of KONA Cotton fabric you dyed YOURSELF. You'll just need to wash it out at home following the instructions.

Fee: \$50 per person to cover dye, supplies, 2 yards of white Kona cotton and instruction On event day, each participant will receive 2 yards of prepared for dying Kona cotton and a set of gloves. You may divide your fabric into FQs or FE's as you see fit. Jay Strebel, world famous tie dye artist, will teach us how to dye each FQ/FE in a different design, including how to mark the fabric, fold and tie and then how to apply the dye. Jammin will supply all the fabric, pre mixed dye, chemical, string and other supplies. Each FQ or FE will be placed in a Ziplock bag with wash out instructions. The dye MUST sit for a full 24 hours prior to wash out in order to get the best results. Participants will be encouraged to post photos of their dyed fabric after wash out to the Guild Facebook page.






LVQ Book Sharing





Easy Leprechaun Shortbread Bites

These melt-in-your-mouth Leprechaun Shortbread Bites, inspired by the magical Emerald Isle, are delicious, easy and so fun to gift to family, friends, neighbors, co-workers, etc. with an adorable, free printable label!

Keyword Irish Shortbread, Leprechaun Shortbread Bites

Prep Time 15 minutes
Cook Time 30 minutes
Total Time 45 minutes

Ingredients

- 1 cup very soft butter
- ½ cup granulated sugar
- ¼ teaspoon almond extract
- ½ teaspoon vanilla extract.
- green food color gel or liquid
- 2 ½ cups all-purpose flour
- ¼ teaspoon kosher salt
- 9 teaspoons multi-colored nonpareils I use green, white and a few pink

Instructions

- Heat oven to 325°F. Line 9-inch square baking pan with foil, leaving a 1-inch overhang on 2 sides. Spray the foil and sides of the pan with nonstick cooking spray. Set aside.
- Combine butter, sugar and extracts in a large bowl. Stir until creamy and well combined. Add the green food color, a little at a time until the desired color is achieved.
- Beat until well mixed. Add the flour and salt and stir with a sturdy spatula or wooden spoon until all of the flour is incorporated. The mixture will be crumbly. Stir in the nonpareils. leaving 1-2 teaspoons for the top.
- 4. Transfer the dough to the prepared pan and pat it to an even layer. I like to use a flat bottom glass or a metal hamburger spatula to help pat and even out the dough. Sprinkle reserved nonpareils evenly over the top and press gently to help them stay in place.
- Refrigerate for 10 minutes then use the foil to lift the dough from the pan onto a cutting surface. Cut the dough into 1-inch squares. Place squares 1-inch apart onto 2 ungreased cookie sheets: discard foil.
- Refrigerate again for at least 30 minutes and up to 12 hours.
- Bake 13-15 minutes or until bottoms just begin to brown. Transfer to a cooling rack and cool completely before storing in an airtight container.
