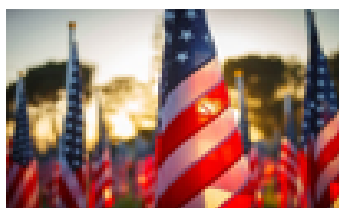

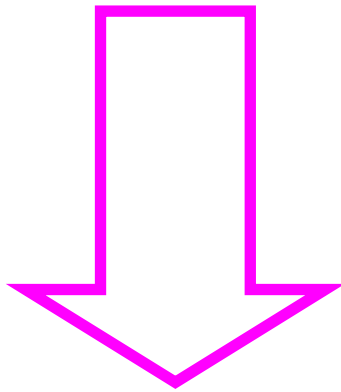
Summer Opportunity 2025

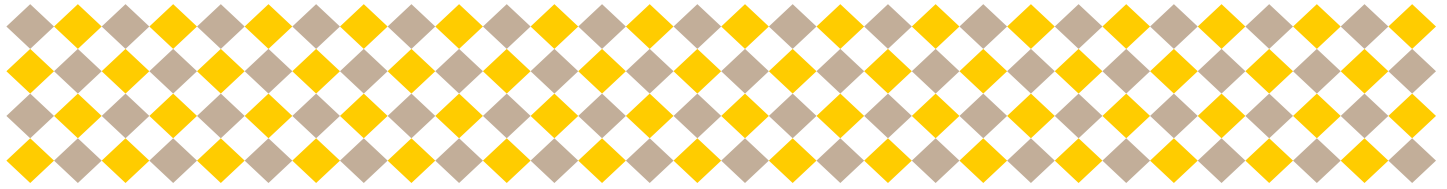

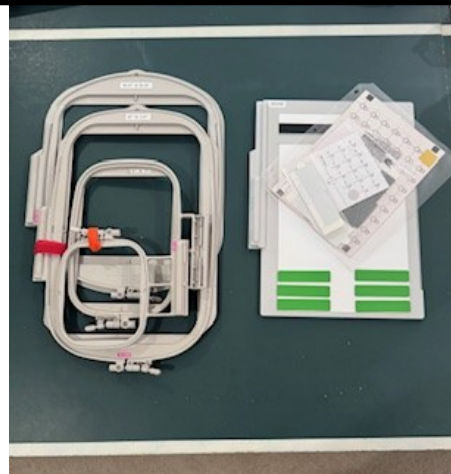
