Quick Tips by Phyllis Suiter

Do you know the 4 ways to make half square triangles?

1: 1 half square triangle at a time:

Take 2 squares cut 1/2 inch larger than the desired finished size, right sides together, draw a line corner to corner sew on the line. Cut 1/4 inch away from the seam and press open then square up to desired size.

2: 2 half square triangles at a time:

Take 2 squares cut 1 inch larger than the desired finished size, right sides together, Draw a line corner to corner. Sew 1/4 inch away from either side of the line. Cut down the center. Press open and square up to desired finished size.


3: 4 half square triangles at a time:

Take 2 squares cut at twice the size of the desired finish size, right sides together, sew 1/4 inch away from the outer edge all the way around the square. Cut along the diagonal both corners to corners. Press open and square up if needed.


4: 8 half square triangles at a time:

Take two squares cut twice the size plus 1 inch the desired finished size, right sides together, draw a line from both corner to corner diagonally then draw a line across the middle both vertically and horizon-

tally. Sew 1/4 inch away from each side of the lines. Make 4 cuts on the drawn lines, press and square up the 8 half square triangles.
