How to Share this Video to Your Guild Online

If your quilt guild is currently meeting online, simply share this PDF document via email using your group's newsletter or messaging system. First attach this PDF to an email ready to send to all members. Then copy the text below to describe the program and explain how it works:

How to Share this Video to Your Guild in Person

Organizing and renting the right equipment to view this video as a group is the responsibility of your guild's Program Chairperson. You will need either a digital projector and projector screen or a Smart TV large enough to be viewed by the entire group. You may be able to rent some of this equipment at your local library. Please check your local area to see what is available at least two weeks before your event.

A video watch page will open. Click the download button (the down arrow) in the upper right corner of the video screen. The video is 7.2 gigs so it may take awhile to download depending on your internet connection.

Once downloaded, move the video to a portable device such as a laptop or USB flash drive. You will need a minimum of 10 gigs of space on a flash drive to hold this file.

On the day of your event, rent your equipment and test it. Double check that you understand how to access the video file from your laptop and how to use the digital projector to display it. This will ensure your guild meeting will be a big success!

After the event, save the downloaded video file on a flash drive for guild members to watch again anytime. Also print copies of the next page so all members have a Citrus Slice motif to take home and practice free motion quilting.

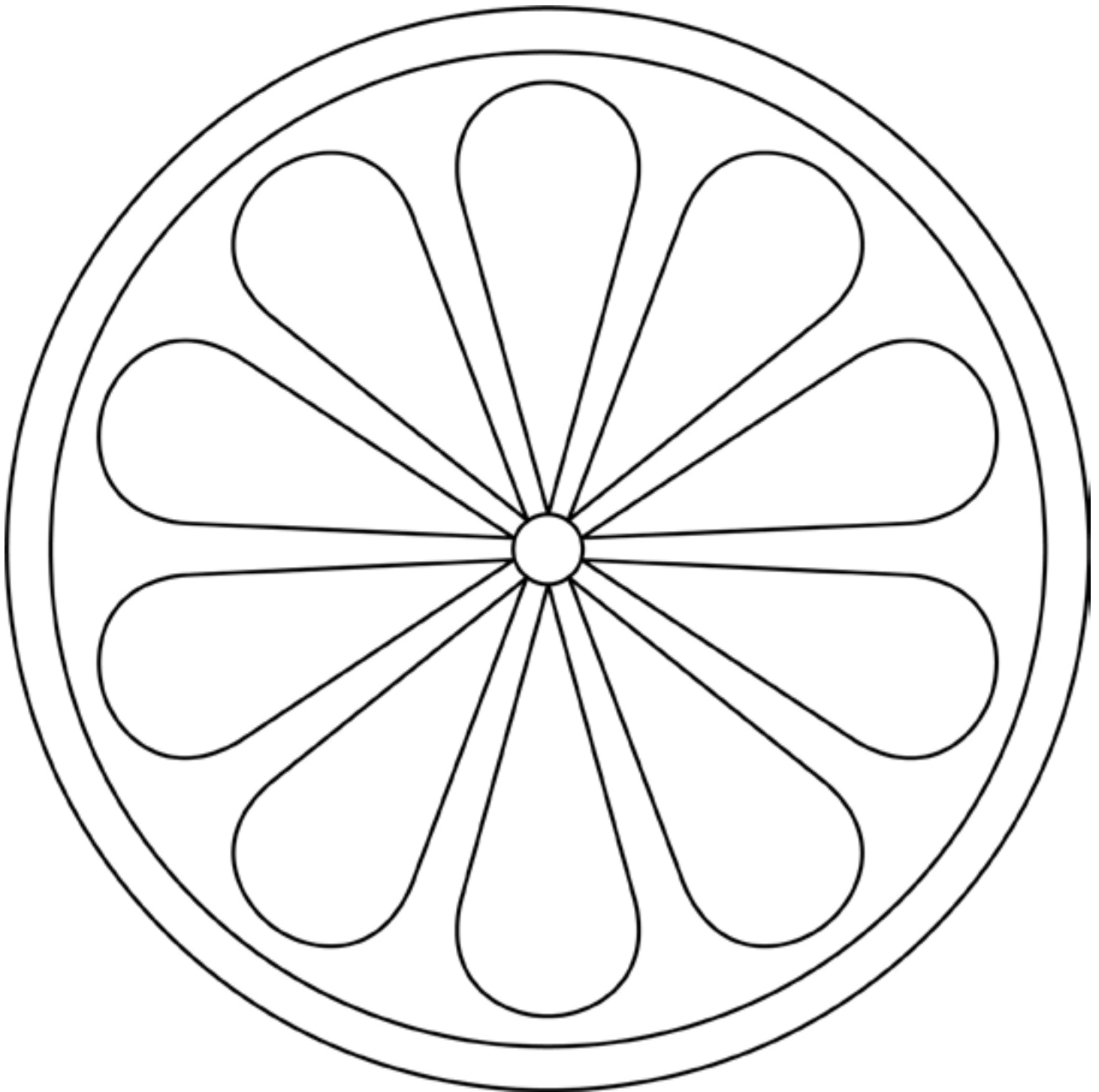
