1 Jelly roll with Dark and light strips or colors that can be contrasted easily.

3 yards of background fabric


1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> yard coordinating Fabric (includes Border and Binding)

Folded Corner Clipper (Available at Christmas Goose or online, \$18.49 on Amazon)

2  $\frac{1}{2}$  inch wide ruler and rotary cutter & Mat

Sewing machine, piecing thread, bobbins. Pins (optional) small scissors Extension cord

Finished size of Quilt: 66  $\frac{1}{2} \times 80 \frac{1}{2}$  inches. Backing Fabric: 4 yards

# Peeps-Stuffed Chocolate Chip Cookies

You'll want to run and tell all of your PEEPS about this recipe!



INGREDIENTS:

1.

2 tubes refrigerated chocolate chip cookie dough
 6 Peeps

Step 1. Preheat oven to 350°.

Separate each roll of dough into six equal chunks. Flatten each chunk into a disc, then sandwich two discs around a <u>Peep</u>, using your fingers to close up the seams so <u>Peep</u> is fully covered in dough. (Each roll of cookie dough will make about three cookies.)

Step 2. Place each <u>Peep</u>-filled cookie dough ball at least 3 inches apart on a parchment-lined baking sheet—cookies will spread a LOT while baking—and bake for 10 to 12 minutes, or until cookies have turned golden brown around the edges. Let cool before serving.
